if You my dear Friend should not think it troublesome i should be very much obliged to You if You would send me either the pattern of one of the ruffles which you work'd in Gobbel stich, i am afraid this is bad spelling but You will Excuse it.

My Compliments to poor Lady Harriet Cornyers, Her spirits i am afraid are not better, will not the Wedding of Miss Sophia be of some comfort to her i have fully determined that my Daughters are not to go to town the 25th of this month which of course will prolong Your stay a Lord Winchelsea to whom and the rest of Your Family i beg You to say every thing that is proper for me. i hope you found the Dutchess of Beaufort some what easier about Lady Mary Sommerset, Sir John Pringle talks with Spirits about her i doubt the anxious Parent to do so.
