Since the unfortunate How
on which ~~His~~ Majesty's

& particularly the Situation
of Prince of Wales has
been full of Difficulty &
Embarrassment.

The Prince & the whole
Royal Family were left to
act for themselves while
the whole Power of Crown
& all the Influence of Office
in & out of Parliament was
in the Hands of Persons
who from the beginning of
Princes had just reason
to apprehend & had after
wards from Experience but
too good reason to know &
did not ~~to~~ entertain very
favorable Dispositions
towards them & who far
from treating them with
kindness & Attention which
the Prince had reason to expect

From those who had been
under such great Obligations
to your Majesty's Favour, have
done every thing in their
Power to alienate from them
the Minds of y^e Majesty's People
& to heap every sort of Indig-
nity on the whole Royal
Family without any Distinction
neither as we conceive ^{have they} been
as attentive as they were in duty
obliged to be to the preservation
of y^e Majesty's just ~~Prerogatives~~
& the legal Rights of y^e Crown

In this delicate & critical
Situation it required the
utmost degree of Prudence
& Circumspection in the Prince
of Wales to avoid furnishing
a Pretext for further Injuries
& Insults & to submit in
Silence to many Things in
order to preserve some appearance
of legal Government in y^e
Nation & in order that y^e
Majesty's just Authority during
y^e Absence should ^{not} receive
some more dangerous
Wound

The Prince & the Royal
Family have just cause to
apprehend that Attempts
will be made to misrepresent
their conduct but they trust
in ^{Yr} Majesty's paternal
goodness & in ^{Yr} Justice
which ^{Yr} Majesty has never
refused to ^{Yr} humblest of
^{Yr} Subjects, that whenever
^{Yr} Majesty shall judge ^{it}
your Majesty may attend
to your Majesty's Affairs
without prejudice to your
Health, that ^{Yr} Majesty
will be graciously pleased
to suspend a Determination
upon any Plan, that may
be suggested by ^{Yr} Ministers
until those of your
own Blood are enabled
to lay before your Majesty
& to submit to your Royal
& fatherly Judgment a
full & fair Representation
of the Circumstances in which
they have stood & the Steps
which have been taken on
all sides in ^{Yr} Majesty's
